# 1

# Register your event

- Put your event on the map as soon as possible so that you can get RSVPs and get access to the resources that you need.
- It doesn't matter if you haven't got all the details yet, you can edit it later.

# Get your resources

- We have guides on how to organise an action for people that have never done this before.
- We will put you in contact with our mobilising team that are on-hand to help you.

# Gather your people

 Gather together with people in your community to plan your action and decide what will be strategic and look great for media. 4

## Plan your action

- Use the Sun and/or the Cross in a dynamic way
- Your action should be public, directed at a clear target or decision maker, and should have a clear ask.

#### Some ideas to get you going:

- Marching to or from a fossil fuel infrastructure site, or perhaps from a renewable energy site to a local government office or town hall.
  Example: Marching from a coal fixed power plant to the local state MD office to demand of the local stat
  - Example: Marching from a coal fired-power plant to the local state MP office to demand a transition to a 100% renewable energy and a just transition for workers in the region.
- Delivering a pledge or petition to a target this could be to your mayor, councillor, faith or education leader.
  - Example: 20-30 people coming together for a petition delivery to your local councillor calling on the council to divest from fossil fuels.
- Rallies, parades, parties, festivals, human signs, murals, massive sun or cross banners. Example: Bringing together 200 people to parade through the streets of your town calling for your city council to declare no new fossil fuel projects or infrastructure in your city.


